Pastor Bob's Renewal Leave

Pastor Bob will be on renewal leave May 20 through July 15. During this time he will be stepping back from the day to day operations of the church to focus on important vision directives for the coming season of ministry here at St. Paul. The Book of Discipline of the United Methodist Church encourages pastors to take a **renewal leave every seven years to model Jesus' rhythm of ministry where the Lord "withdrew from the crowds"** to engage into a deliberate season of prayer and renewal. While he is away, Pastor Pam will assume all clergy responsibilities. Guest pastors have also been scheduled to preach Sunday sermons during this time. What a gift our church leadership is giving our senior pastor as he spends time in deeper spiritual renewal to return even stronger for the many years ahead.

Rummage Sale Announcement

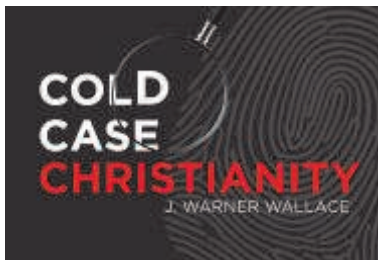
