### Pastor Bob's Renewal Leave

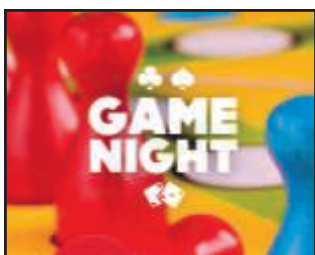

several students next year, and we hope to recruit more and possibly expand to a second school as the program grows. Our lives were changed by these students, and we pray that the Lord will water the seeds we planted in their lives.
