Changes to Online Giving

A new, easier to use online Giving Page is coming this week. You can still set up recurring gifts or make a one time gift. You can also pay for flowers, class study materials and all the other ways you are used to using online giving. The difference is that the page is more streamlined so it's easier to use, and it's directly tied into our member database and financial records so it will make our Financial Team's job easier as well.

What the New Giving Page Looks Like



Register once and your billing information will be saved, making it easier for the next time you give. You can also give without registering, but you will need to enter your information again the next time you give.

Use the drop down to select what your payment is for. You can add more than one fund, payment type or giving area to a single payment.

Use an e-check (ACH) or a credit card to make your payment. We ask that you check the box when making a credit card payment to add 3% to your payment or gift and offset the fee we are charged for each online payment. There is no fee for ACH payments.

If you currently make a recurring payment, we will contact you and walk you through the process of stopping the old payment and starting a new payment on the new giving system. The old system will remain in place for a few months to allow everyone to transition.

When the pages switch this week, you will be able to reach the new page the same way you have reached the old giving page. Visit **stpaulumc.org** and click the Giving button at the top of the page or the Giving link under the Worship menu.

JOY Luncheon This Tuesday



Hurricane Irma created havoc all around us last year, and as we enter this year's hurricane season each one of us needs to be ready should a hurricane hit the Bay area again this year. Here are some key things that you can do *today* to help be ready:

- Prepare an emergency kit Build an emergency kit including items listed below like food, water, medical needs and important documents. Put in waterproof containers.
 - ☐ Flashlights
 - ☐ Bottled water (1 gallon/person/day)
 - ☐ Bottled Juice
 - ☐Two coolers drinks/food
 - Manual can opener
 - ☐ Canned Foods
 - ☐ Battery-operated radio
 - ☐ Battery-operated lanterns
 - ☐ Matches
 - ☐ First Aid Kit
 - ☐ Clock
 - ☐ Plastic garbage bags
 - ☐ Scissors
 - ☐ Heavy gloves
 - ☐ Clean clothes
 - ☐ Extra blankets & Pillows
 - Tweezers
 - Sunscreen
 - ☐ Thermometer
 - ☐ Soap/Shampoo/Hygiene items
 - ☐ Extra cash
- Make a communication plan Make sure your family knows how to get in touch with each other if you are separated. Have a discussion to determine who would be your out-of-state point of contact and make sure everyone has a cell phone so you can communicate with others and let them know you are safe.
- Learn evacuation routes Determine where you would go and how to get there.

Let's all be prepared so we have the best case scenario should a major storm come our way!



Manuela Nuela: Manuela's parents both died of HIV/AIDS. While they were ill, Manuela was being cared for by an older sister who was only 11 years old. After the parents died, the girls went to live with their grandmother, who made alcohol and would often leave for days at a time. The girls had to find their own food, were often sick and were una-

ble to attend school regularly. Now she and her older sister are doing better at GRACE home. Manuela is a funny, sweet child, always ready with a big smile. She is often seen taking care of younger children and singing in the children's choir.
