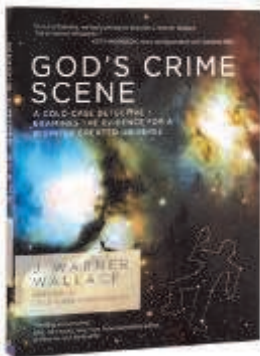

## Back to School Jubilee

Preparations are underway for the Back to School Jubilee on Saturday, August 4. Each year, with your help, we distribute school supplies, backpacks, shoe vouchers and more to pre-registered children in our community. Last year we served 425 children! This year we hope to also provide supplies and backpacks for some of the South Sudanese refugee children who are being served by Carolyn Goodwin. If you want to help with this year's Jubilee you can:

### TAKE A TAG

Visit the school bus in the lobby and take a few tags with supplies listed on them. Buy the listed supplies and drop them off in the circular bin in the lobby on Sunday or at the church office during the week.

### DONATE MONEY

If you would like to make a donation toward the purchase of shoe vouchers and supplies, or to help us provide school supplies to South Sudanese refugee children, you can make a monetary donation. Place your donation in the offering plate, and be sure it is labelled "Back to School Jubilee."

### SERVE AS A VOLUNTEER

Sam, Dennis and James are brothers whose mother died and whose father, a soldier, was killed in battle. They were being cared for by their grandmother and uncle, but their grandmother was in poor health and their uncle had a family of his own, making it difficult to care for three extra children, so they came to the GRACE home orphanage.

**Sam's personality has really developed since coming to GRACE Home.** He is happy and a good student. He loves playing soccer. He recently won the gold medal in the Refugees Road Race in Uganda.

Dennis is quiet and shy but is always engaged in activity with the other children.

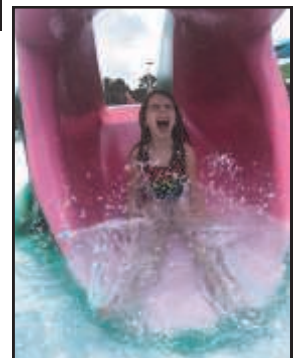
James is shy but always quick with a smile and hug. He loves making crafts in Sunday School.
