## JUMPSTART MENTORING FOR SUCCESS

Jumpstart is our middle school mentoring ministry for the students of Largo Middle School. When the new school year begins in August we will need volunteers to fill the following roles:

### Adult Supervisors

Adult Supervisors oversee high school tutors and middle school students. An education background is not required, just a willingness to get to know students and to help where they can. We also need adults to help serve dinner and clean up, and to oversee games and recreation in the gym.

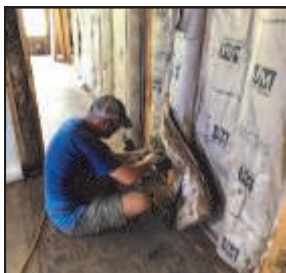
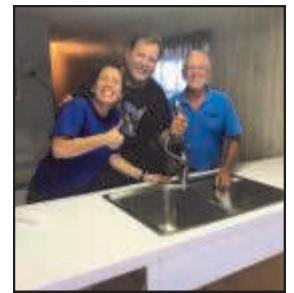
# GOOD NEWS
