

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. (1 John 5:14, NIV)

Why do we need to pray?

We need to pray for comfort, for healing, for guidance, for compassion and forgiveness and because we are so often afraid due to a problem or situation in our life. When we don't know which way to turn or what we should do, prayer is a way to find peace and guidance.

Scripture tells us not to worry, not to be afraid, yet when we try to handle our problems and concerns by ourselves, that's exactly what happens; we worry, fret and are anxious. If we would only give up control and ask our God to help us, the fear and anxiety would go away. When we turn to Him in prayer, our heavenly Father comforts us, heals our spirit and gives us peace.

If you have a prayer need or concern and would like someone to pray with you, come to *Stay and Pray* next Sunday, August 4 in the chapel after either worship time and allow members of our prayer team to pray with and for you. Give up your pain and troubles to God and discover the comfort and peace that he gives back
