


Talk Saves Lives: Suicide Prevention

Adult Supervisors oversee high school tutors and middle school students. An education background is not required, just a willingness to get to know students and to help where you can. We also need adults to help serve dinner

and clean up, and to oversee games and recreation in the gym.

#### HIGH SCHOOL TUTORS

Tutors must have at least one advanced or AP class. Students can use their volunteer time towards the Bright Futures scholarship, which requires community service, or for National Honors Society hours



#### HIGH SCHOOL MENTORS

High school students can also earn community service hours by mentoring our middle school students during dinner or gym time from 6:00-7:30 p.m. AP and honors classes are not required for this time slot.

#### TRAINING AND TEAM BUILDING DATES

Training for new volunteers and tutors will be on Tuesday, September 10. Tutors will train at 4 p.m. Adults will train at 5 p.m. We will also have a team building session for all student tutors and adult supervisors on Tuesday, September 17 at 4 p.m.
